Ideas for use in the kitchen

1. Place dangerous cleaners out of reach of small children.
2. Use security latches in drawers and cabinets.
3. Place covers on all stove burners.
4. Keep fire extinguishers within quick and easy reach.
5. Get rid of plastic shopping bags.

Ideas for use in the bathroom

1. Never leave young children unattended in the bathroom.
2. Never leave a bathtub filled with water unattended.
3. Buy covers for all electric outlets.
4. Keep all medications in bottles and out of reach of children.
5. Install a seat latch seat on the toilet.
6. Always shut the hot water off first when filling the bathtub or sink.
7. Keep razors and blades in a secured cabinet and dispose of blades outside in the trash.

Ideas for use in the living room

1. Keep fans and heaters and beyond the reach of children.
2. Remove or shorten any cord electric within the reach of children.
3. Keep the toys collected and returned to their place of storage.
4. Keep the windows closed and secured.
5. Secure furniture with loose or sharp edges.

Ideas for use in the bedroom

1. Keep the pillow out of the cradle until the baby is one year of age.
2. Never leave a baby in a closed room without adult supervision.
3. Make sure that cabinets can open from the inside.
4. Keep toys that are not baby proof out of the reach of children.
5. Remove batteries from all toys that the baby may have access to.
