Sexually Reactive Children

Solution Based Casework

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- **1.** Parents will want to **respect each family member's privacy** by having family rules around bathing, dressing, and sleeping.
- 2. It is helpful for parents to provide clear instruction and <u>support for not</u> <u>keeping secrets.</u>
- Parents will need to teach their children, with the help of others, about acceptable and non-acceptable touching behavior for themselves and others.
- 4. The children may need help from their parents or others to learn the difference between affection and sexual touch.
- 5. These children find it helpful to <u>talk about their feelings and fears in a</u> <u>safe environment.</u>
- 6. Parents will want to develop a **positive plan for managing behaviors** such as nightmares, bedwetting, soiling, aggression, masturbation, etc.
- These children benefit from patient parents with clear expectations.
 <u>Parents may need a personal plan</u> to help keep themselves calm and non-reactive.
- Parents need a plan to ensure that <u>others respect their child's physical</u> <u>and emotional boundaries.</u> This would include other family members, caretakers, and family friends.
